

Tea 4 Me MIYO Mug Cover

**Make your own single colorway
MIYO mug cover with a 100 yd
sock yarn mini.**

Skills Required

Suitable for knitters familiar with working in the round in stockinette and rib stitches.

Needles

2.25 mm / US 1 dpns

Yarn

Total yardage: 70 yds/ 64 m light fingering weight.

Sample shown in **Lady Dye Yarns, 2 BIG Mini Skein in 'Pumpkin'** superwash merino (100 yards, 92 m)

Mug Cover Size

Height: 6 in / 15 cm to fit the 16oz MIYO mug.

Gauge

7.5 sts = 1"

Glossary

CC – contrasting color

CO - cast on

dpn - double pointed needles

k – knit

kfb – knit in front and back of the stitch, increasing 1 stitch.

MC - main color

p - purl

pm - place marker

rnd – round

sts – stitches



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Tea4Me Mug – one color stockinette stitch.

Begin working in the round starting with two double pointed needles as follows:

CO 30 sts. Distribute for 10 sts on each of 3 dpn.

Join for working in the round.

Rnd 1: Knit. Check to make the circular opening just fits over the nub at the bottom of the mug.

Rnd 2: *(K1, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 45 sts

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: *(K2, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 60 sts

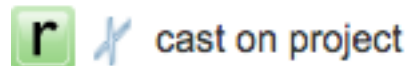
Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: *(K9, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 66 sts

Knit until piece measures 5 ½ inches / 14 cm.

Finish with rib stitch in CC: *(K3, p3) repeat * until ribbing measures ½ inch / 1 cm, about 8 rows.

Bind off. Weave in ends, soak, and dry on mug.
