Tea 4 Two MIYO Mug Cover

Make your own MIYO mug cover with two 50 yd sock yarn minis.

Skills Required

Suitable for knitters familiar with working in the round in stockinette and rib stitches.

Needles

2.25 mm / US 1 dpns

Yarn

Total yardage: 70 yds/ 64 m light fingering weight.

i.e. <u>Lady Dye Yarns</u>, superwash merino blend (100 yards/91.44 m)

MC: 1 mini skein "Limeon" CC: 1 mini skein "BamBam"

Mug Cover Size

Height: 6 in / 15 cm to fit the 16oz MIYO

Gauge

mug.

7.5 sts = 1"

Glossary

CC – contrasting color

CO - cast on

dpn - double pointed needles

k - knit

kfb – knit in front and back of the stitch, increasing 1 stitch.

MC - main color

p - purl

pm - place marker

rnd - round

sts - stitches



















Tea4Two Mug – stripes two contrasting colors

Begin working in the round starting with two double pointed needles as follows:

Main Color(MC): CO 30 sts. Distribute for 10 sts on each of 3 dpn. Join for working in the round.

Rnd 1: Knit. Check to make the circular opening just fits over the nub at the bottom of the mug.

Rnd 2: *(K1, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 45 sts

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: *(K2, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 60 sts

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: *(K9, kfb) repeat * to end of round. 66 sts

Knit with MC for 2 inches / 5 cm.

Add CC.

Rnd A (CC): Knit one rnd.
Rnd B (MC): Knit 2 rnds.

Repeat Rnd A and B 2 more times.

Rnd C (CC): Knit 2 rnds.
Rnd D (MC): Knit one rnds.

Repeat Rnds C and D 2 more times. Knit with CC until piece measures 5 1/2 inches / 14 cm.



Finish with rib stitch in CC: *(K3, p3) repeat * until measures ½ inch / 1 cm.

Bind off with the CC. Weave in ends, soak, and dry on mug.


