Easy Fingerless Mitts

Skills Required

• Cast on, bind off, knit stitch.

Materials

Yarn/Size

• 80 yards Worsted Weight Brown Sheep Lanaloft, or any other worsted weight yarn.

Needles/Notions

- Size 8 straight needles, at least 10" long.
- **Darning Needle.** a big, often plastic, needle that you can thread yarn through to tie the whole thing together when you're done.

Gauge

· 4.5 stitches per inch

Glossary

BO - bind off

CO - cast on

k - knit

Instructions

CO 26 stitches.

Row 1: Knit. Row 2: Knit.

Continue until you have 70 rows or until it fits around your wrist. (7.5 inches long x 6 inches wide)

Bind off all Stitches.

Create a tube from the knitted rectangle.
Using darning needle first stitch 5 stitches together.

Skip 8 stitches to allow for thumb hole, threading yarn through bound off stitches to hide as you go.

Then continue stitching the final 13 stitches closed.
